Cliff Davis, Deputy Chief

Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD), Nevada
Deputy Chief Cliff Davis joined the LVMPD on September 29, 1969. Over his 36-plus years with the department, he has spent the majority of his time in Field Services, with assignments in Internal Affairs and Crime Prevention. Commander Davis is credited with introducing to the department the philosophy that initiated the Crime Prevention concept. He started the Neighborhood Watch, which is considered the department's most successful crime prevention program. He was promoted to Commander in February 2002. Commander Davis currently is assigned to Valley District of the Patrol Division where he oversees the activities of the Northwest, Southwest, Northeast and Bolden Area Commands. Deputy Chief Davis has been a member of the NLPOA Las Vegas/Clark County Chapter for the past 11 years.
